

DIGITAL EVIDENCE

Detective Daren Ford of the Weld County Sheriff's Office will present a two hour workshop regarding Lab Services for Digital Evidence. Topics will include dealing with large scale investigations in a regional lab environment, and how we will prepare for the future needs of digital evidence. Detective Ford has been performing Video and Computer examinations since 2002 and is certified as a Forensic Computer Examiner through the International Association of Computer Investigative Specialists.

Detective Trevor Anderson of the Greeley Police Department will present a two hour workshop to discuss Cell Phone Forensics. Topics will include cell phone technology, collection, analysis, and investigative applications. Detective Anderson is a Certified as a Forensic Computer Examiner through the International Association of Computer Investigative Specialists and has been performing forensic electronic examinations since 2004.

Corporal Aaron Horwitz of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office will present a two hour workshop to discuss collection and preservation of digital evidence. Topics will include best practices concerning on scene disassembly and documentation, encryption concerns, and an outlook on future concerns. Corporal Horwitz has been performing forensic examination since 2008 and is currently working on his Computer Certification through the International Association of Computer Investigative Specialists.

Delmar Buhrman is a Criminalist and Digital Multimedia technician/analyst with Fort Collins Police Forensic Services and assigned to the Northern Colorado Regional Forensic Laboratory, Greeley Colorado. The presentation will be two hours on Digital Multimedia Evidence. The focus will be on video but will include audio and still imagery, technology, collection, analysis, and investigative applications.
